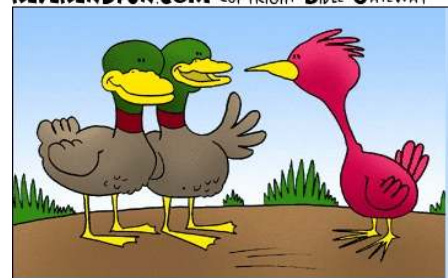
### OPERATION RICE BOWL ~ A LENTEN TRADITION
