

MINUTES OF THE ST. PIUS X COUNCIL 10-30-23

The regular meeting of the St. Pius X Parish Council was held on Tuesday, October 30th, 2023 at 6:30 pm at the parish house called by Fr. Joe Holzhauser. In attendance were the council members Mike Wiley, Greg Yackley, Joe Sovell, Tawana Grueb, Secretary Raechael Wiley, and Greg Lorenz.

The meeting was opened with a prayer led by Father Holzhauser. The previous meeting minutes, financial report, and the new agenda were approved by Mike Wiley and Greg Yackley with consensus of the Council.

Basement Project: The walls are being put up and should be painted by the weekend. Counters will not be put in until after the "The Night before Christmas" and small safety items as fire extinguishers and safety outlets needing to be installed. It should be completed by Jan. 1st.

Faith Formation class: Father Joe reported that he attended a Faith Formation Class and was impressed with the attendance and attentiveness of the students. He was happy that things were going well.

Set A Blaze: Father said that the Diocese will send a survey out to everyone concerning how well Set A Blaze is doing in the Parishes. The Bishops will review the results and come up to an agreement of what should be changed. The plan is to have this completed by the first of May.

Other: Need more volunteers to clean the church and no Sunday Brunch until after Jan. 1st.

Attendance is up at St. Pius X.

Father Joe was asked what the parish should do if a Priest does not show for mass? He is considering it. But we cannot have communion without a Priest.

Father concluded the meeting with a prayer at 8:05.
